Capital Beltway HOT Lanes Pre-Construction Work Continues

Preparing Staging Areas

Work Area:

- **Georgetown Pike staging area:** gravel placement and fence construction.
- **Chain Bridge Road:** brush/tree removal and gravel placement.
- **I-66 Interchange:** brush/tree clearing and installation of sediment controls. During heavy rain, sediment controls help ensure dirt stays on the job site and runoff water remains clean. One Beltway lane at I-66 will be closed this week during off-peak hours to safely move heavy equipment in and out of staging areas. In two weeks a barrier will be placed around one staging area to help ensure safety.
- **Braddock Road:** work will begin later this month.

Purpose of Staging Areas

Eight staging areas will be used to house construction supplies and equipment needed for I-495 Capital Beltway HOT Lanes construction.

Post- Construction

After completion of HOT lanes construction in 2012, some construction areas will be converted into storm water management ponds and all areas environmentally restored.

Surveying

Surveying crews will continue to be out along the Leesburg Pike interchange as well as Chain Bridge Road and Dulles Toll Road.

Boring Operations

Four crews with mobile boring equipment will be taking soil samples to determine geologic conditions in various areas. These samples are used by highway designers and engineers to better understand existing conditions as bridge and highway foundations plans are developed and reviewed. Temporary lane closures will occur in areas where samples are drawn from the existing highway.
