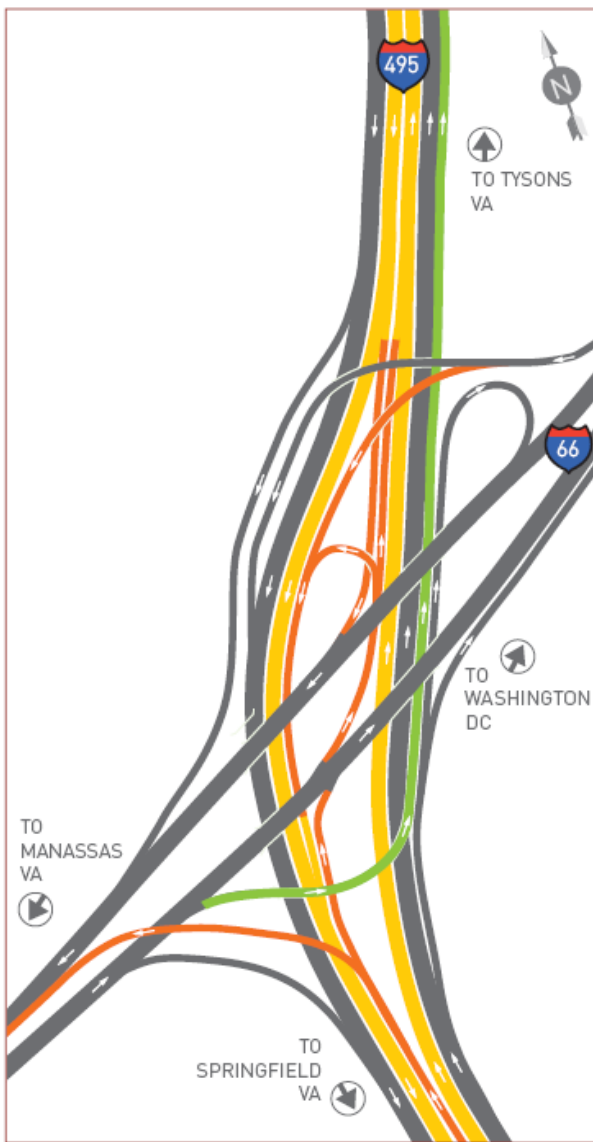


## Capital Beltway HOT Lanes: Rebuilding the I-66 interchange to improve travel flow and connectivity

As part of the Capital Beltway HOT Lanes Project, the Virginia Department of Transportation, Transurban and Fluor are rebuilding the I-66/I-495 interchange to deliver significant benefits to drivers traveling through this major interchange, especially for those going from I-66 East to I-495 North towards Tysons. At I-66, ten new bridges will be built to accommodate the four new HOT Lanes on the Beltway as well as provide smoother connectivity between these two major interstate highways.

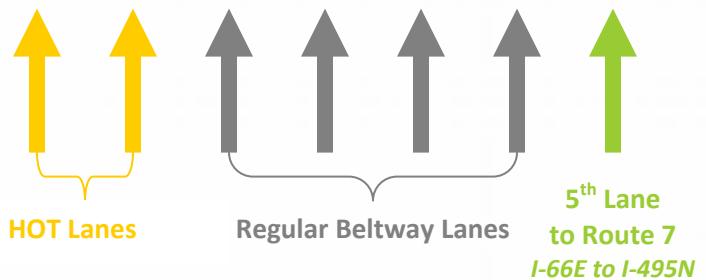
### New traffic pattern: I-66 to I-495N

### I-66 East to Tysons: more choices, more lanes

Three additional lanes when HOT Lanes open



#### When HOT Lanes open in late 2012:

##### *New travel choices to Tysons from I-66*

Carpools (HOV+3), buses and toll paying drivers traveling from I-66 East to I-495 North towards Tysons, will have a seamless merge onto the two free flowing northbound HOT Lanes with three new exits in Tysons at Leesburg Pike, Westpark Drive and Jones Branch Drive.

#### Today's challenging commute:

##### *I-66 East to I-495 North towards Tysons*

Today, anyone traveling from I-66 East to I-495 North towards Tysons, merges onto the Beltway in the far left lane. Those with a destination at Tysons have to quickly merge across four lanes of Beltway traffic to exit in Tysons at Routes 7 or 123.

#### New flyover ramp and new 5th lane:

##### *Providing smoother ride onto Beltway lanes and to Tysons*

A new flyover ramp from I-66 East to I-495 North will provide a smoother transition onto I-495 North by bringing drivers onto the Beltway in the right lane with a new 5th lane extended to Route 7 in Tysons. No more crossing over four lanes of traffic; drivers heading from I-66 East to Tysons on I-495 North using the regular Beltway lanes will be able to stay in the new 5<sup>th</sup> lane all the way to Route 7.
